Arthur Street School in Dunedin faced a pressing need for additional learning spaces to accommodate its growing student population. To address this challenge, the school embarked on a project to install four 12m x 6m temporary classrooms and a 3.6m x 3m ablution block. This project was executed in three stages, with the first two classrooms installed in March 2019, the ablution block in 2022, and the final two classrooms in January 2023. One of the most significant challenges encountered during this project was the sensitive nature of the site. The location was identified as an ancient Maori burial ground, requiring meticulous oversight by an archaeologist during all excavation activities. This added layer of complexity made site works particularly challenging and required a delicate balance between progress and preservation.

The additional space has allowed the school to accommodate its growing population comfortbaly. The classrooms offer a comfortable and conducive space for learning, while the ablution block provides essential facilities for students and staff.
